
Reflection Cards

Write about a time when you struggled to forgive someone. How can Jesus' teachings on forgiveness in Matthew 18:21-22 help you to forgive?



Reflect on Jesus' parable of the sower in Matthew 13:1-9. What kind of soil are you? How can you cultivate a heart that is receptive to God's word?



Read Mark 1:1-8 and reflect on John the Baptist's message. What does it mean to prepare the way for the Lord in your own life?



Write about a time when you felt overwhelmed by a situation. How can Jesus' words in Mark 4:35-41 encourage you to have faith in the midst of storms?



Reflect on Jesus' call to discipleship in Mark 8:34-38. What does it mean to take up your cross and follow Jesus?



Write about a time when you struggled to understand something in the Bible. How can Jesus' parables in Mark 4:10-13 teach you to listen and understand God's word?



Reflect on Mary's song of praise in Luke 1:46-55. What does it teach you about God's character and plan for salvation?



Write about a time when you felt discouraged. How can Jesus' words in Luke 12:22-34 encourage you to trust in God's provision?



Reflect on Jesus' parable of the prodigal son in Luke 15:11-32. What does it teach you about God's love and forgiveness?



Write about a time when you struggled to love your enemies. How can Jesus' teachings on love in Luke 6:27-36 help you to love others?
