How to Use These Cards

To integrate the Sibling Relationship Cards into your family's life, place them in a common area where they are easily accessible. Make it a part of your daily routine by encouraging your children to select a card each morning. Begin by reading the scripture on the card together and discussing its meaning in simple, relatable terms. Focus particularly on the action suggested on each card, encouraging your children to think about and apply these actions in their day-to-day interactions. Regularly remind and praise your children for demonstrating the behaviors encouraged by the cards. At the end of the day, take a moment for reflection, discussing how the day's lesson was applied, and sharing experiences. As parents, leading by example is crucial; demonstrate how these Biblical principles are integral to family values. Encourage your children to seek God's guidance in living out the teachings of the cards through prayer.
